

PRIVACY POLICY - FAST

FAST is a programme operated by Resonance Health Analysis Services Pty Ltd ("Resonance"). FAST is designed to provide information and support to Registered Users by providing, amongst other things, the following:

- a system for data collection and patient result release;
- a communication link between Registered Users and Resonance;

This policy sets out how FAST uses your personal information (or that of your patients) and explains:

- The information we collect
- Use and disclosure of the information
- Security

In this Privacy Policy, words defined in the Terms and Conditions for FAST and the Service Agreement for FerriScan Service, have the same meaning, unless otherwise stated. The following definitions apply in this Agreement.

The organisation to which this policy applies is Resonance Health Analysis Services Pty Ltd ABN 11 092 813 244 ("Resonance"). This statement outlines Resonance's policy on how it uses and manages information provided to or collected by Resonance through FAST.

Resonance is bound by the Australian National Privacy Principles contained in the Privacy Act (Commonwealth) 1988 (the "Act"), except in relation to any acts or practices which are specifically exempted by the Act.

Resonance may, from time to time, review and update this privacy policy statement to take account of new laws and technology, changes to Resonance's operations and practices and to ensure FAST remains relevant to users. Any changes to this policy will be posted on FAST.

The type of information Resonance collects and holds includes (but is not limited to) your name and address details, email address, other contact details, practice details and information relating to undertaking the FerriScan service.

Resonance may collect more specific information about you or your centre if you request or acquire a specific product or service from Resonance or participate in other activities conducted by Resonance.

In operating FAST, Resonance generally uses information for the following purposes:

- to provide you with products or services you have requested
- to help Resonance manage and enhance its products and services
- to communicate with you
- to provide you with ongoing information in which Resonance believes you will have an interest
- to give you the opportunity from time to time to receive e-mail and 'e-newsletters' from Resonance

Resonance collects information from you for the purposes described above, each of which is a primary purpose. It also collects that information for such other secondary purposes that are related to one or more of the primary purposes.

Resonance may, in appropriate circumstances, also provide your information to companies or individuals Resonance engages to perform functions on its behalf, such as mailing of information, providing e-mail services, conducting marketing activities, data analysis and research, and to anyone you authorise.
